





- * Glitter

- * Pre-cut shapes



Tips & Tricks

- * Accent your scrapbook pages with whatever's in your craft stash – glitter, buttons, felt, pipe cleaners, rhinestones, washi tape, etc
- * Attach embellishments with adhesive foam tape to add dimension
- * Scrapbook outside the lines – extend elements off the page
- * Attach circular embellishments with brads so they can spin
- * Mix textures and colors to create eye catching pieces
- * Don't feel trapped in working only in straight lines, play around with curves and squiggles
- * Borders don't have to be limited to the edges, play around with placement to create natural dividers


















- * Adhesive foam tape

Tips & Tricks

- * Accent your scrapbook pages with whatever's in your craft stash – glitter, buttons, felt, pipe cleaners, rhinestones, washi tape, etc.
- * Attach embellishments with adhesive foam tape to add dimension
- * Layer clear glass cabochons on top of circular elements to make them 3-dimensional
- * Use a circular punch to cut out perfect circles
- * Make your own memory orbs by printing the designs on transparency paper and layer them over your photo
- * Memories can change, so feel free to include more than one character per memory or page
- * Bring your memories to life by adding tokens or keepsakes from it

Tips & Tricks

- * Accent your scrapbook pages with whatever's in your craft stash – glitter, buttons, felt, pipe cleaners, rhinestones, washi tape, etc.
- * Attach embellishments with adhesive foam tape to add dimension
- * Use the designs as a jumping off point and use page backgrounds and embellishments that are in the same theme
- * Layer speech bubbles directly on photos
- * Make the pages personal by incorporating your child's handwriting and work
- * Utilize the empty space with decorations and embellishments. Remember, the more, the merrier!
- * The characters have a wide emotions and expressions, use them to convey your feelings across the pages


