# STENCIL CRAFT



## YOU WILL NEED:

T-shirt, Newspaper, Craft Knife or Scissors, Non-toxic spray paint.



## DIRECTIONS

Have an adult help you cut along the dashed lines using a craft precision knife or scissors. Save the positive and negative pieces. Prepare an area to work on your t-shirt in a well ventilated room or outdoors. Protect your work area by laying down newspaper.

Pre-design your stencil by placing the pieces on top a piece of newspaper in the configuration that you like. Use non-toxic spray paint to spray the positive and negative pieces to create your design. When you are happy with your design, lay your t-shirt flat on top of the protected work area, and paint it according to your design! Let dry.

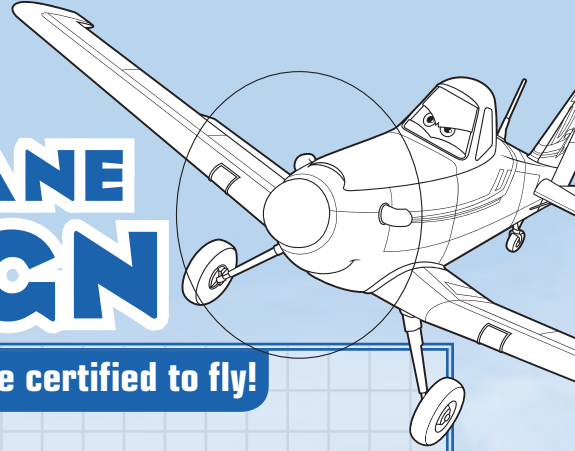

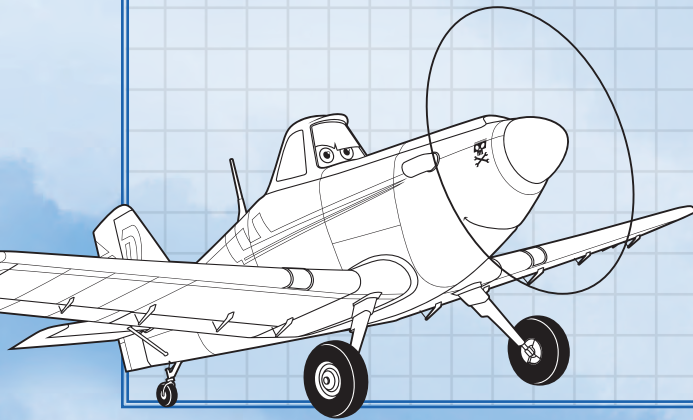

### **7/29-8/4 EAA AirVenture Oshkosh**

**Wittman Regional Airport, Oshkosh, WI**  
Famous for over 500,000 visitors and massive fly-in of aircraft. Multiple displays as well as talks by influential people in aviation.

### **8/9-11 Abbotsford Air show Abbotsford, BC**

Canada's largest air show/aviation festival.

### **8/15-18 Airbourne 2013**

**Eastbourne Seafront, East Sussex, UK**  
The world's largest free sea front air show.

The European equivalent to EAA AirVenture Oshkosh, Tannkosh attracts hundreds of private aircraft from all over Europe.

### **8/29-9/1 Bournemouth Air Festival**

### **9/11-15 Reno Air Races Reno, Nevada**

Known as the "Worlds Fastest Motor Sport" Features civil air show acts and military flight demonstrations between races.

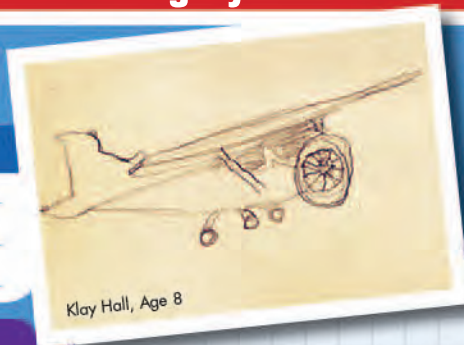

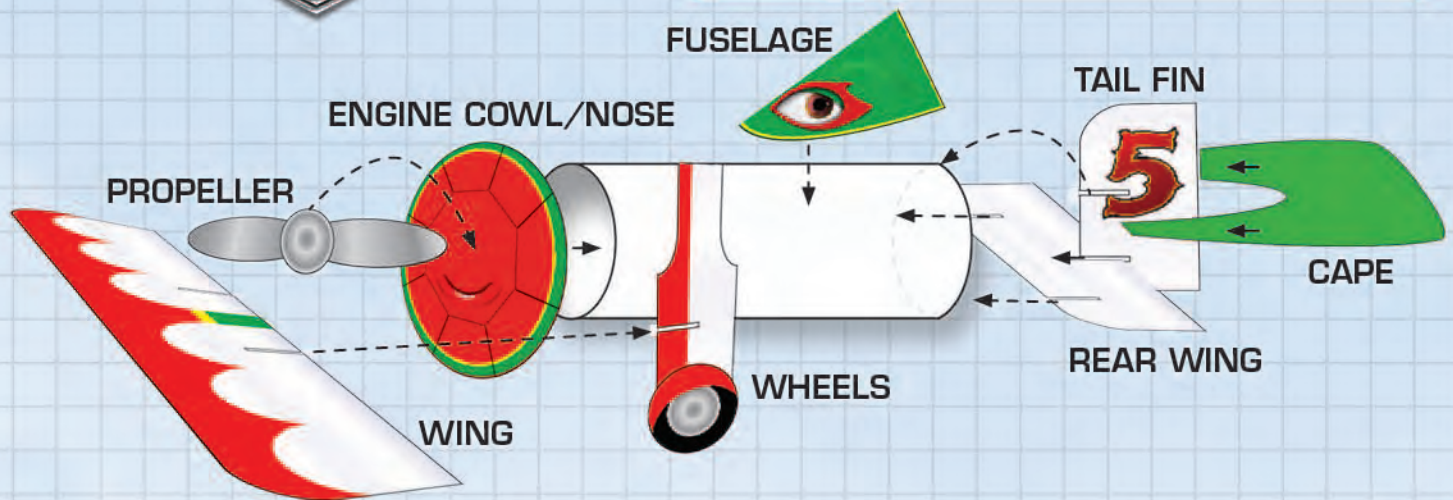

# EL CHUPACABRA TUBE PLANE



## YOU WILL NEED:

Empty Toilet Paper Roll,  
Glue, Brass Fastener,  
Scissors, Thick Paper  
or Card Stock.

## DIRECTIONS:

Have an adult help you with this activity!

- 1) Print the attached pages on thick paper or card stock.
- 2) Have an adult help you cut out each piece from the template. Then carefully cut small slits where indicated. Set aside.
- 3) Wrap the toilet paper roll with the wheels making sure the connection joints are facing forward. Attach to the wings from the bottom of the toilet paper roll. Secure with glue.
- 4) Place the propeller in the center of the engine cowl/nose and secure with a brass fastener or glue.
- 5) Take the engine cowl/nose and place it on the (front side) open end of the toilet paper roll. Fold around the toilet paper roll and secure with glue.

6) Have an adult help you cut three slits on the back side of the toilet paper roll.

7) Slide the rear wing into the slits on the back side of the toilet paper roll. Secure with glue.

8) Slide the tail wing into the slit of the back side of the rear wing and to the slit at the top of the toilet paper roll. Secure with glue.

9) Slide the cape around the wing and secure towards the center-top of the toilet paper roll with glue.

10) Bend the

fuselage to snugly fit the top of the toilet paper roll, covering the ends of the cape.



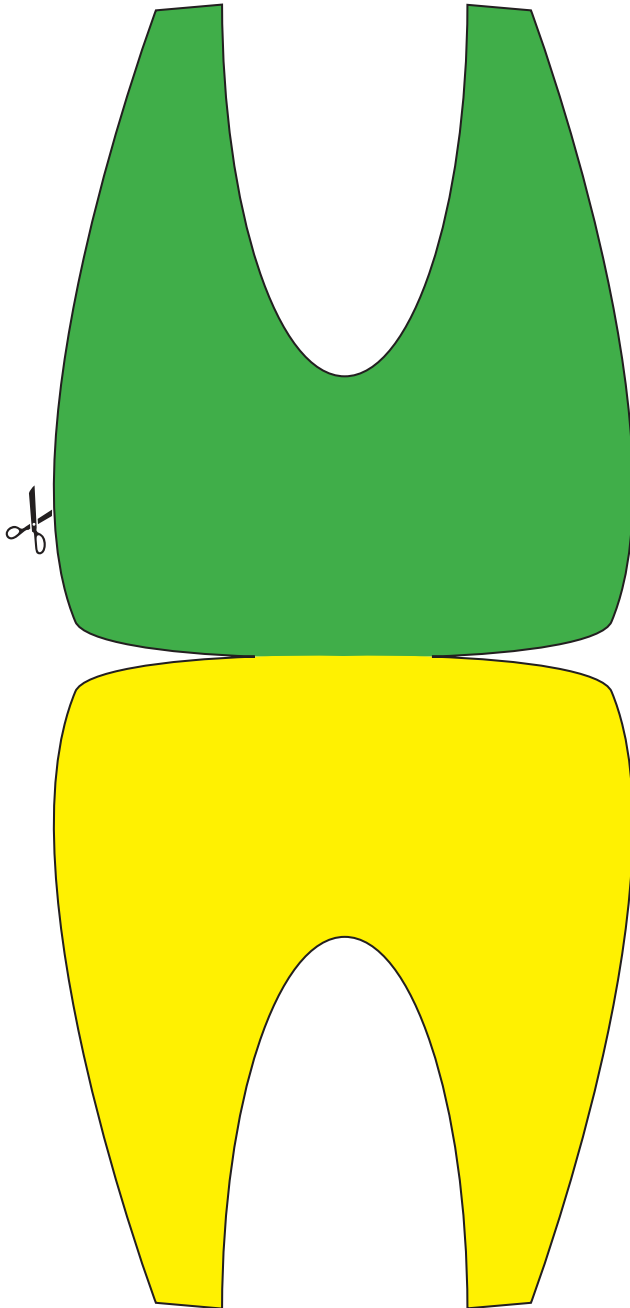

Have each person throw their paper plane at the same time, the person whose plane crosses the finish line first WINS the round. Place a penny on the game board to indicate the WINNER for that round. Adjust your paper planes and continue to play until all the rounds are complete. The person who crosses the finish line first for four rounds is the WINNER!

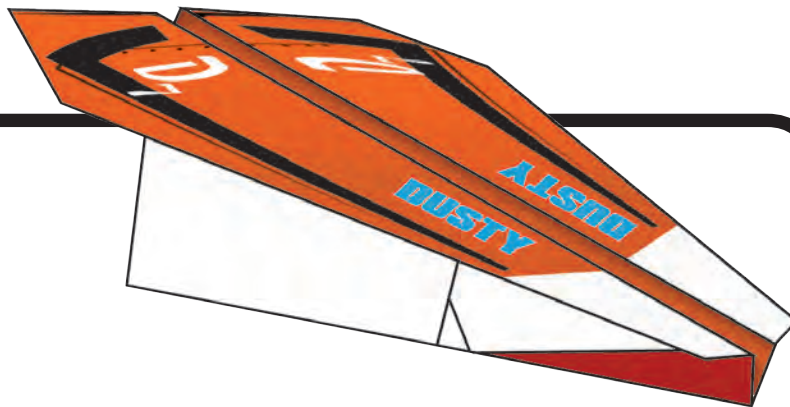
